

Leading Epidemic Control through Accelerated Programs (LEAP)

LEAP stands for **Leading Epidemic Control through Accelerated Programming**. The goal is to accelerate progress towards reaching case identification, linkage to ART and retention targets. This is a CDC-Kenya initiative and it is Rapid results initiative. Other PEPFAR programs have 'SURGE'. This will be undertaken in all sites, with intensive focus selected high priority sites and counties.

Why LEAP?

- Kenya is on the last stretch towards achieving epidemic control
- HTS_Pos Tx_NEW FY 19 and Tx_Net_New target achievement were suboptimal at SAPR 19
- Both target achievement and program quality are key

Objectives of LEAP

- To grow the treatment cohort by 23,622 by end of September 2019
- To increase partner performance in low performing SNUs to reach or surpass 80% target achievement for priority indicators by end of September 2019
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
